Travel back through the decades with Roy, Buddy and Elvis as the King joins the line-up of this always-popular rock 'n' roll spectacular!

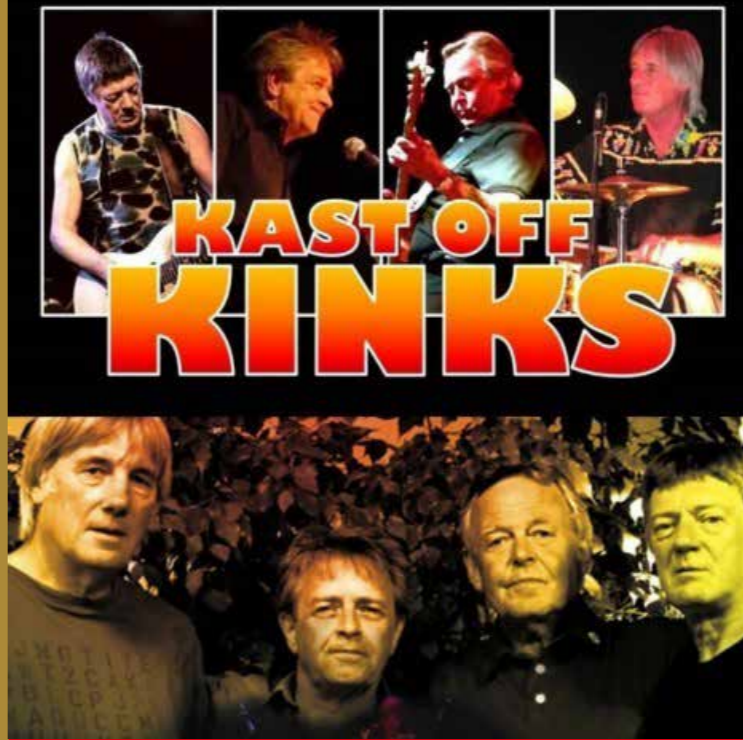
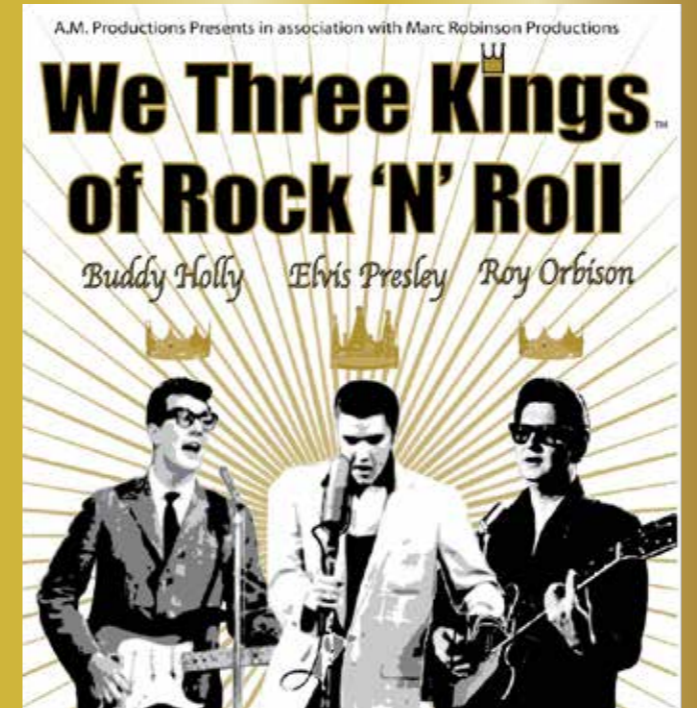
