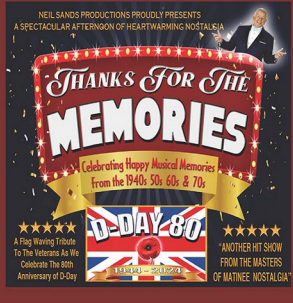

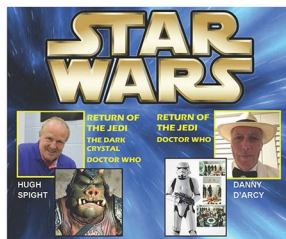

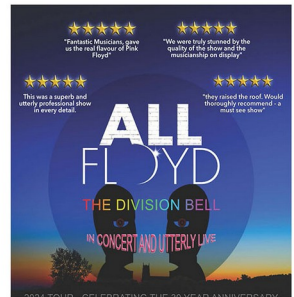
All Floyd

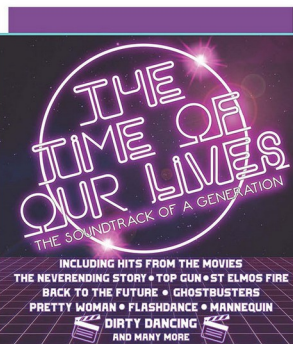
