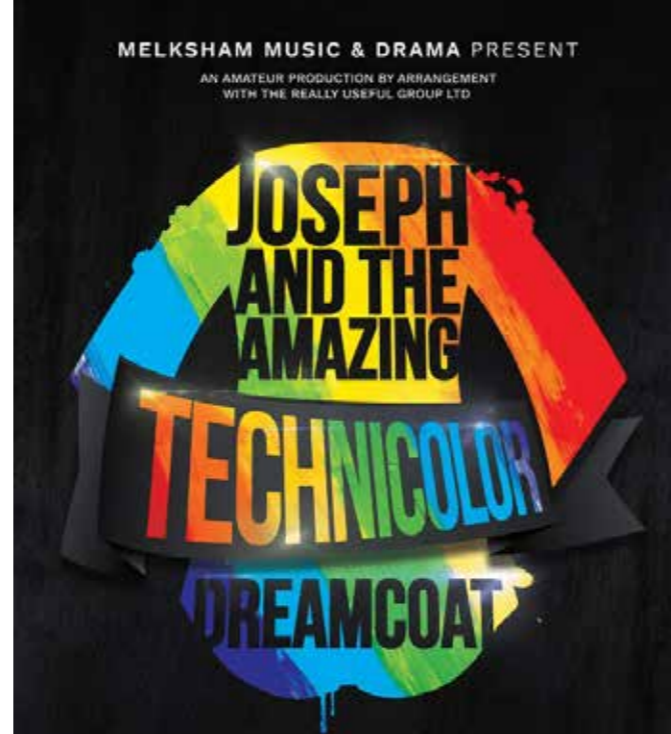

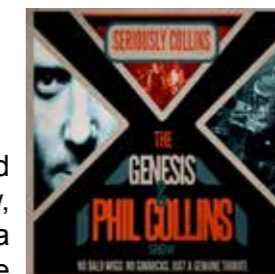
The Unravelling Wilburys

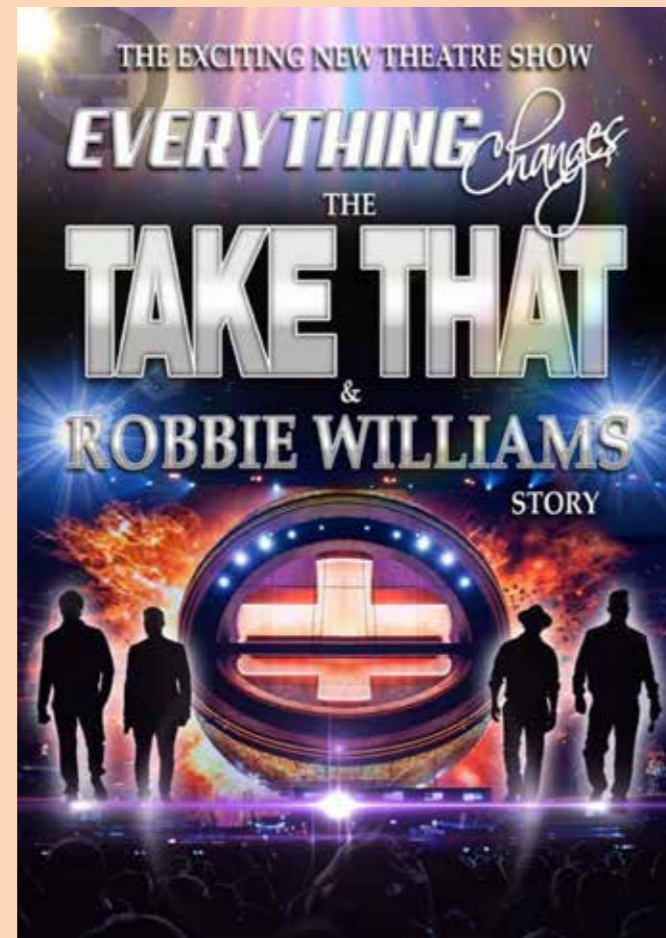
