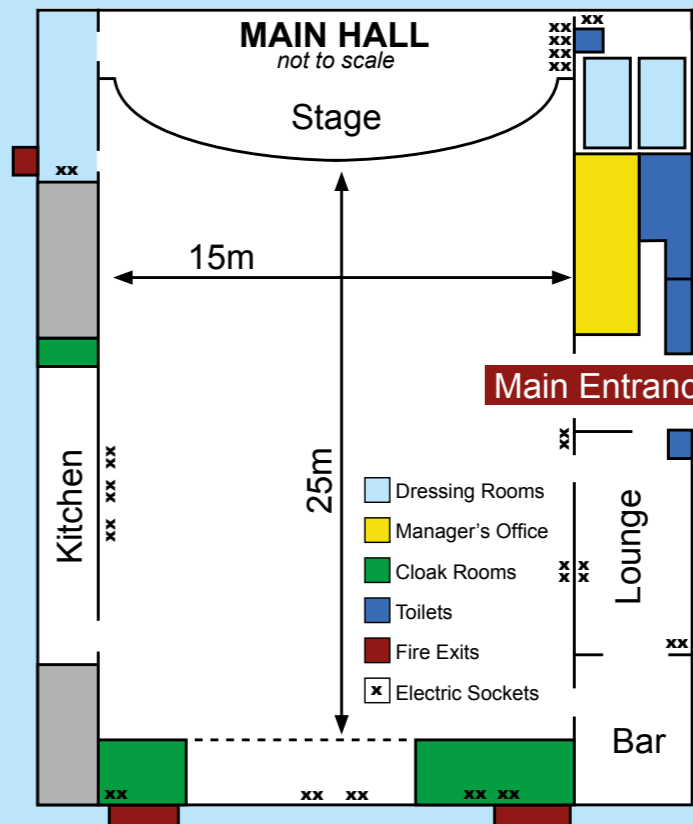

price. Screenings take place monthly, so check www.melkshamassembly.co.uk or follow @AHFilmClub on Twitter to keep up-to-date.

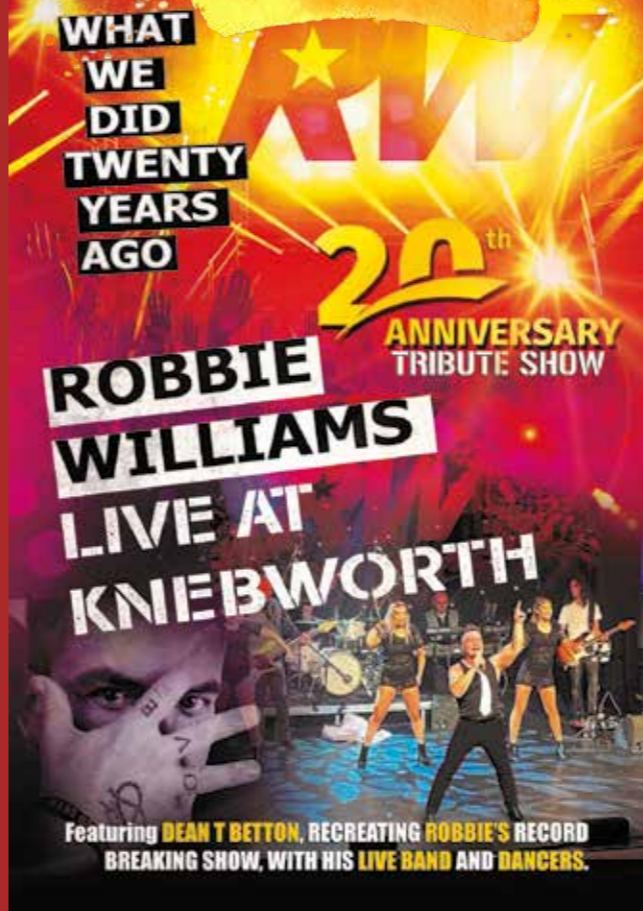
MELKSHAM RECORD FAIR
